HY09 vs HY08 (6 months)

Revenue

The Group's revenue decreased by RMB 205.6 million (or 50.53%) to RMB 201.3 million in HY09 compared to the previous corresponding period. The decrease in revenue was due mainly to the decrease in the sales of Finished Zippers (RMB 100.1 million), Zipper Chains (RMB 83.7 million) and Zipper Sliders (RMB 88.9 million) (collectively known as "Zipper Segment"). This was partially offset by the increase in revenue from the Knitting Wool (RMB 6.7 million) and Trading (RMB 60.4 million) segments.

The decrease in revenue from the Zipper Segment was attributable to the decrease in the Group's export business for both direct overseas customers and export oriented garment factories. The decrease in the average selling prices of the Group's Zipper Segment was as a result of more competitive prices being offered to our customers to retain the Group's working relationship with them as well as a decrease in raw materials prices.

The Knitting Wool and Trading segments were introduced in the second half of FY2008 following the setting up of the Group's Shanghai factory and its Hong Kong office respectively.

Gross Profit and Gross Profit Margin

The Group's gross profit decreased by RMB 116.7 million (or 76.40%) to RMB 36.1 million in HY09 compared to the previous corresponding period. Gross profit margin of the Group declined by 19.63% to 15.23% in HY09. This was largely attributable to the lower average selling prices from the Zipper Segment (as explained above) coupled with a lesser decrease in our raw material prices.

The gross loss in the Knitting Wool segment was attributable to an increase in raw materials costs.

Other income and other expenses

Other income comprises government subsidies while other expenses mainly consist of bank charges. The net decrease was due mainly to the write back of allowance for doubtful trade receivables (RMB2.0 million) following the stepping up of the Group's collection efforts.

Selling and distribution expenses

Selling and distribution expenses decreased by RMB 0.6 million (or 25.59%)to RMB 1.7 million in HY09. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in the salaries and commission paid in HY09 as a result of a decrease in Group's revenue.

General and administrative expenses

General and administrative expenses increased by RMB 4.4 million (or 50.88%) in HY09 compared to RMB 2.3 million. This was largely due to the RMB 2.5 million provision for doubtful debts and the accrual of RMB 1.2 million for annual audit fee.

Interest income and expenses

Interest expenses increased by RMB 1.9 million (or 68.72%) to RMB 4.6 million in HY09. This was attributable to the increase in short-term loans, bills payable to banks and bank overdrafts during HY09. Interest income was higher in HY09 as a result of an increase in cash and bank balances.

Foreign exchange (loss) gain

The foreign exchange gain in HY08 arose due to the translation of bank balance denominated in Japanese Yen as a result of higher JPY/RMB exchange rate. This bank balance was withdrawn in 3QFY08. In HY09, there were no significant bank balances denominated in foreign currencies. The foreign exchange loss in HY09 arose as a result of the strengthening of RMB against our foreign currencies such as HKD, SGD and USD which are mainly used for the transactions of the Group's Hong Kong sales office andprofessional expenses incurred.

2Q09 vs 2Q08 (3 months)

Revenue

The Group's revenue decreased by RMB 96.1 million (or 44.27%) to RMB 120.9 million in 2Q09. The decrease in revenue was due mainly to the decrease in sales of the Finished Zippers (RMB 55.0 million), Zipper Chains (RMB 44.1 million) and Zipper Sliders (RMB 47.2 million) segments (collectively known as "Zipper Segment"). This was partially offset by the increase in revenue derived from the Knitting Wool (RMB 4.4 million) and Trading (RMB 45.8 million) segments.

The decrease in the 2Q09 revenue from the Zipper Segment was attributable to the decrease in export business for both direct overseas customers and export oriented garment factories.

The Knitting Wool and Trading segments were introduced in the second half of FY2008 following the setting up of the Group's Shanghai factory and its Hong Kong office respectively.

Gross Profit and Gross Profit Margin

The Group's gross profit decreased by RMB 63.5 million (or 77.52%) to RMB 18.4 million in 2Q09. The Group's overall gross profit margin declined by 22.53% to 15.23% in 2Q09. This was largely attributable to lower revenue from the Zipper Segment as explained above.

.The gross loss in the Knitting Wool segment was attributable to an increase in raw materials costs.

Other income and other expenses

Other income comprises government subsidies while other expenses mainly consist of bank charges. The net decrease was due mainly to the write back of allowance for doubtful trade receivables (RMB2.0 million) in 2Q08 following the stepping up of the Group's collection efforts.

Selling and distribution expenses

Selling and distribution expenses decreased by RMB 0.3 million (or 26.61%) to RMB 1.0 million in 2Q09. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in the salaries and commission paid in 2Q09 as a result of a decrease in the Group's revenue.

General and administrative expenses

General and administrative expenses increased by RMB 1.0 million (or 33.06%) in 2Q09. This was largely due to the RMB 1.2 million provision for doubtful debts and the accrual of RMB 1.2 million for annual audit fee.

Accordingly, the Group has provided for deferred tax liabilities on the Group's profit-making PRC subsidiaries' net profit attained in HY09. As Jade Star (the PRC's subsidiaries' immediate holding Company) was incorporated in the British Virgin Islands, the applicable withholding tax rate is 10%.

Interest income and expenses

Interest expenses increased by RMB 0.9 million (or 80.43%) from RMB 1.2 million in 2Q08 to RMB 2.1 million in 2Q09. This was attributable to the increase in short-term loans, bills payable to banks and bank overdrafts in 2Q09. Most of the short-term loans and bills payable had been settled in June 2009. Interest income was higher in 2Q09 as a result of an increase in cash and bank balances.

Foreign exchange loss

The foreign exchange gain in 2Q08 arose due to the translation of bank balance denominated in Japanese Yen as a result of higher JPY/RMB exchange rate. This bank balance was withdrawn in 3QFY08. In HY09, there were no significant bank balances denominated in foreign currencies. The foreign exchange loss in 2Q09 arose as a result of the strengthening of the RMB against the foreign currencies of HKD, SGD and USD.

FINANCIAL POSITION

Non-current assets

As at 30 June 2009, non-current assets amounted to RMB 237.1 million comprising property, plant and equipment, land use rights and intangible assets.

The Group's property, plant and equipment amounted to RMB 193.2 million, a 15.29% (or RMB 25.6 million) increase compared to FY08. The increase was due mainly to the completion of staff hostel and enhancement of the electricity supply system.

Current assets

Current assets decreased by RMB 193.6 million (or 16.65%) in 2Q09. This was largely due to a decrease in trade receivables, other receivables and prepayments which was offset by the increase in inventories and cash and bank balances.

Trade receivables decreased by RMB 101.7 million in tandem with the decrease in revenue in 2Q09.

The decrease in other receivables and increase in cash and bank balances were due mainly to monies received from a director. The amounts had been inadvertently transferred to the director as a result of misinterpretation over certain transactions which resulted in incorrect accounting entries passed and was rectified in 2Q09. Details of the misinterpretation had been disclosed in the Group's Full Year Announcement for the full year ended 31 December 2008 dated 26 February 2009 (Announcement No.: 00278).

Current assets (cont'd)

The increase in inventories was due mainly to the increased purchase of raw materials to take advantage of the decrease in price of raw materials during the period.

Current liabilities

In 2Q09, current liabilities amounted to RMB 127.1 million representing a decrease of RMB 170.3 million (or 57.27%) This was attributable to the decrease in trade payables, short-term bank loans, other payables and accruals. In 2Q09, the Group settled RMB 96.0 million of short-term bank loans and also RMB 24.2 million of bills payables.

Cash Flow

The Group's cash and cash equivalents increased due to the repayment of the amount due from a director. The increase was offset by the repayment of short-term bank loans and bills payable.

The external demand for zipper and zipper products continued to remain weak as a result of the economic downturn since mid-2008. Competition is more intense within the local zipper market as some of the Group's competitors focused on the local market, with lower demand from the foreign market.

The raw materials prices for zipper products have remained relatively stable since the last quarter and are unlikely to be as volatile as in the previous year.

The Group will enhance its brand name and develop the appropriate sales strategies to retain its current market share and remain competitive. It will also explore further business opportunities to acquire those businesses within the supply chain of the zipper products.

With the Group's good reputation in the industry and its well vertically integrated manufacturing operation, the Group believes it has the competitive advantage to meet new challenges ahead when the economic situation improves.
