6M2015 vs. 6M2014

Revenue

The Group's revenue increased by RMB 47.7 million (or 18%) to RMB 315.0 million. The increase was due mainly to the increase in revenue of the Trading segment (RMB 54.3 million) and the Processing segment (RMB 1.7 million). This was partially offset by the decrease in revenue contributions from the Zipper Chain segment (RMB 3.6 million) and the Zipper Slider segment (RMB 2.5 million).

The inter-segment sales elimination represented the dyeing and electroplating services provided by the Processing segment to the Zipper segment.

The decrease in revenue from the Zipper segment in 6M2015 was attributable to a deteriorating market for the zipper industry in the PRC which was adversely affected by the general slowdown in the global economy. This had resulted in the Group reducing its selling prices to retain customers' orders. The average selling prices in the Zipper Chain segment had decreased by 9% per kg while the sales volume had increased by 8%.

The Group's Trading segment relates to the sourcing and buying of certain raw materials in accordance to customers' requirements. The profit margin and all purchases are based on confirmed sales, i.e. the Group does not hold any inventories. As such, the volume of trading depends on the opportunities available so as the profitability and price movements which are dependent on customers' demand for raw materials. The increase in revenue from the Trading segment was due to an increase in the sales orders from customers during 6M2015.

Gross Profit and Gross Profit Margin

The Group's gross profit decreased by RMB 3.8 million (or 14%) to RMB 22.8 million. The decrease in gross profit was due mainly to the increase in wages and factory overheads.

Average gross profit margin decreased by 1.7 percentage points to 11.0% due to the decrease in gross profit margin from the Zipper segment in 6M2015 arising from the lower selling prices and higher production costs such as increase in wages and factory overheads.

Other income and other expenses

Other income comprises government subsidies and refund of unclaimed cash dividend distribution while other expenses represented foreign exchange loss. The net income decrease was due mainly to the decrease in government subsidies and increase in foreign exchange loss as a result of the depreciation of USD and SGD against RMB arising from the balance in the Company's bank account.

Selling and distribution expenses

Selling and distribution expenses decreased by RMB 0.1 million (or 2%) to RMB 3.0 million. The decrease was due mainly to a decrease in advertising costs as a result of fewer promotional activities.

General and administrative expenses

General and administrative expenses decreased by RMB 3.0 million (or 11%) to RMB 25.1 million. This was mainly due to the RMB3.3 million decrease in allowance for doubtful debts as a result of tighter controls over customers' credit period and limit.

Finance income and expenses

Finance expenses increased by RMB 2.9 million (or 80%) to RMB 6.6 million. This was attributable to the increase in short-term bank loans.

2Q2015 vs. 2Q2014 (3 months)

Revenue

The Group's revenue increased by RMB 2.6 million (or 2%) to RMB 162.7 million. The increase was due mainly to the increase in revenue of the Trading segment (RMB 13.9 million), and the Processing segment (RMB 1.0 million). This was partially offset by the decrease in revenue contributions from the Zipper Chain segment (RMB 6.4 million) and the Zipper Slider segment (RMB 5.0 million).

The inter-segment sales elimination represented the dyeing and electroplating services provided by the Processing segment to the Zipper segment.

The decrease in revenue from the Zipper segment in 2Q2015 was attributable to the reduction in selling prices to retain customers' orders.

The increase in revenue from the Trading segment and the Processing segment was due to an increase in the sales orders from customers during 2Q2015.

Gross Profit and Gross Profit Margin

The Group's gross profit decreased by RMB 2.0 million (or 14%) to RMB 12.6 million. The decrease in gross profit was due mainly to the increase in wages and factory overheads.

Average gross profit margin decreased by 0.6 percentage points to 11.1% due to the decrease in gross profit margin from the Zipper segment in 2Q2015 arising from the lower selling prices and higher production costs such as increase in wages and factory overheads.

Other income and other expenses

Other income comprises government subsidies and refund of unclaimed cash dividend distribution while other expenses represented foreign exchange loss. The net expenses represented the decrease in government subsidies and increase in foreign exchange loss as a result of the depreciation of USD and SGD against RMB arising from the balance in the Group's bank account.

Selling and distribution expenses

Selling and distribution expenses increased by RMB 0.2 million (or 16%) to RMB 1.7 million as a result of increase in staff costs following the recruitment of more experienced sales staff.

General and administrative expenses

General and administrative expenses decreased by RMB 3.2 million (or 23%) to RMB 10.8 million. This was mainly due to the RMB 3.7 million decrease in allowance for doubtful debts as a result of tighter controls over customers' credit period and limit.

Finance income and expenses

Finance expenses increased by RMB 1.9 million (or 99%) to RMB 3.8 million. This was attributable to the increase in short-term bank loans.

FINANCIAL POSITION

Non-current assets

As at 30 June 2015, non-current assets amounted to RMB 651.4 million comprising property, plant and equipment, investment property, land use rights, intangible assets and prepayments.

The Group's property, plant and equipment amounted to RMB 308.4 million, a decrease of 5% (or RMB 15.6 million) compared to RMB 323.9 million as at 31 December 2014. The decrease was due mainly to depreciation expenses.

The increase in investment property was due to the recognition of the construction cost of the Group's Xiamen Headquarters project ("HQ Project") during 6M2015.

The decrease in intangible assets was due mainly to the amortization expenses.

Current assets

As at 30 June 2015, current assets amounted to RMB 820.6 million, an increase of 6% (or RMB 48.2 million) compared to RMB 772.4 million as at 31 December 2014. This was due largely to an increase in inventories, trade and other receivables, bank deposits, cash and bank balances which were offset by the decrease in prepayments.

Inventories increased by RMB 35.6 million (or 53%) to RMB 103.4 million due to a build-up of inventory as a result of the decline in sales in 2Q2015 while production still continued on an optimal scale to cover its manufacturing overheads. Moreover, the Group held a 3-month raw materials requirement for the purpose of production efficiency compared to a 2-month raw materials requirement as at 31 December 2014.

Trade and other receivables increased by RMB 24.9 million (or 9%) to RMB 294.5 million was in line with the increase in revenue from the Trading segment.

The decrease in prepayments to suppliers was due mainly to the decrease in advances made to certain suppliers. For advances to suppliers, the Group will secure signed supply agreements with its various suppliers. The advance payments in the supply agreements are calculated based on a certain percentage of the total contract price.

Cash and bank balances increased by RMB 11.9 million (or 4%) to RMB 297.5 million due mainly to the increase in short-term bank loans.

Current liabilities

As at 30 June 2015, total current liabilities were RMB 683.2 million, an increase of 9% (or RMB 53.9 million) compared to RMB 629.3 million as at 31 December 2014. This was mainly attributable to the increase in short-term bank loans. The increase was offset by the decrease in trade payables, bills payable to banks, income tax payable, other payables and accruals and amount due to a Director.

The increase in short-term bank loans was due mainly to a new bank loan of RMB48.3 million secured. Please refer to page 4 for further information.

Trade payables decreased by RMB 1.0 million (or 17%) to RMB 4.8 million, and bills payables decreased by RMB 20.9 million (or 16%) to RMB 112.9 million due to settlement of some trade and bills payables during 6M2015.

Other payables and accruals decreased by RMB 1.3 million (or 1%) to RMB 202.9 million due to decrease in advances received from customers.

Bank overdrafts represented the drawdown of the banking facilities from Hang Seng Bank.

The decrease of amount due to a Director was due to funds repaid to Mr Hong Qing Liang for the HQ Project after the Group obtained the new short-term bank loan.

Non-current liabilities

Non-current liabilities comprise deferred tax liabilities. The increase in deferred tax liabilities was due mainly to the increase in withholding tax as explained above under the note for tax expense.

CASH FLOW

Operating activities

Net cash flows used in operating activities in 6M2015 amounted to RMB 69.3 million compared to RMB 81.7 million in 6M2014, and in 2Q2015 amounted to RMB 21.4 million compared to RMB 1.9 million in 2Q2014. This was due mainly to the increase in inventories, trade and other receivables.

Investing activities

Net cash flows used in investing activities in 6M2015 amounted to RMB 16.8 million compared to RMB 14.4 million in 6M2014, and in 2Q2015 amounted to RMB 9.9 million compared to RMB 9.7 million in 2Q2014, due mainly to the purchase of property, plant and equipment and construction of the HQ Project in 2Q2015 and 6M2015.

Financing activities

Net cash flows used in financing activities in 6M2015 amounted to RMB 97.6 million compared to RMB 79.8 million in 6M2014, and in 2Q2015 amounted to RMB 46.8 million compared to RMB 4.1 million in 2Q2014, due mainly to the proceeds from new banking facilities in 2Q2015 and 6M2015.

For 6M2015, the Group continued to operate under a highly competitive and challenging environment as the zipper industry in the PRC faces intense competition with thin profit margins. Apart from the challenging and competitive business environment, the Group also faces weak demand for zippers as most of its customers still hold a high level of inventories in their warehouses. As such, the Group had to lower its selling prices to retain customers and attempt to increase sales orders.

The average utilization rates of the Group's production facilities in 6M2015 for its zipper chains and zipper sliders were approximately 75% and 54% respectively.

The Group expects the zipper industry to remain highly challenging and competitive. The Group expects the continuation of the slowing economic growth in the PRC, uncertainties for export sales, as well as cost pressures arising from rising production and labour costs. These factors will affect the Group's operating outlook for the next twelve months.

The Group will continue to strive to enhance its operational efficiency of its plants through automation of its production processes, so as to mitigate the impact of weak demand to the Group's gross profit margins. The Group will also continue to exercise tight control on the administrative expenses and strive to lower its production unit cost.

Update on Construction progress of the Group's Xiamen Headquarters.

As of to-date, the HQ Project is approximately 70% completed. The Group had obtained shareholders' approval on 28 April 2015 to dispose part of the office building of the HQ Project when opportunity arises.
